1 – 5 September	World Championships, Milan, Italy (approximate tour dates 17 August – 6 September)

Important Notes

1. Squad officials are as follows: Nick Burnett nick.burnett@airways.co.nz (team coach); applications close for the team manager role on 30 November 2009; and Penny Dustin dusties@paradise.net.nz (Squads Director).
 2. To participate in the NZ Women's Squad players must submit the application form (download from www.canoepolonz.org.nz) and non refundable \$100 application fee no later than 21 December 2009. Due to the timing of the first camp players are requested to submit their application and make travel arrangements to the first camp as early as possible.
 3. All squad members are required to play in a 2010 National League team entered in the women's A grade.
 4. The 2010 NZ Women's Squad will have an elite focus with best possible performance at the World Championships being the aim. The national coach may cut players from the squad at any time during the campaign. The first camp will be open entry. Athletes performing at a suitable level will be invited by the coach to the second camp.
 5. Attending all training and selection events is compulsory. Exemptions must be sought for non attendance. A 50% penalty of the actual cost of each camp shall be applied to the ledgers of squad members who do not attend a training camp. This shall be applied without exception.
 6. An accounts clerk is contracted for the purpose of managing the Association's squad accounts. An individual squad ledger will be sent to each squad member following each training camp and the tour. The ledger will detail funds received from the squad member and costs allocated to them. Claims for credits for squad expenses (e.g., cost of travel to training camps) must be submitted on the official form available from www.canoepolonz.org.nz and will show as credits on the squad members ledger.
- Members who owe money to the Association and have made no arrangements to pay shall not be permitted to participate in any New Zealand Canoe Polo tournaments or activities.
7. Squad members will be required to sign a squad contract that binds them to adhere to the Association's policies. In addition, each individual is personally responsible for ensuring any supplements or medications they take comply with the WADA code and Drug Free Sport NZ requirements.
